The Lake Superior Performance Rally is a large event that is spread out over hundreds of square miles across the beautiful Upper Peninsula. An event of this magnitude cannot happen without the volunteers who come out and help. Volunteers of all experience levels are always welcome and can help out by serving in a number of roles.

Some positions include:

Course Marshals - No experience necessary, marshaling is a great place to start! Some marshals monitor intersections on the stages to ensure that no unauthorized cars or people enter the stage while it is hot, others work at spectator areas to ensure all spectating is done in designated areas and as safely as possible.

Control Workers - Arrival and Finish control workers work the beginning and end of each stage and record times. There are also time control workers that work in the service areas.

Radio Operators - Efficient communication is key to the success of the rally. Licensed HAM radio operators are needed to provide the safety net for the rally.

Medical Operators - Medical teams are located at various locations on the stage to assure minimal response times in case any medical assistance is needed.
